With the new academic year approaching, I would like to remind parents of the school uniform expectations. Children are to wear:











Dark grey or black skirt, shorts or trousers

White polo shirt, shirt or blouse.

Navy blue cardigan or sweatshirt. <u>Dorset Printwear</u> provide our school logo version

In the Summer, dark blue checked dresses can be worn.

Socks should be white or black.

Shoes should be black. Black trainers can be worn if preferred.

PE kits should be in school at all times. Children are to wear:

Plain white t-shirt Black shorts Leggings/jogging bottoms Trainers/plimsolls.

We have lots of preloved uniform that can be purchased via the FABS for a small donation. The uniform will be out in the playground on the last afternoon. Please enquire at the office in September if you require it once the new term starts.
