#### Dear Parents and Carers,

As I sit and write the newsletter on a Thursday afternoon with bright sunshine now beaming down on our playground, you would not believe the snow that we encountered this morning and the disruption it caused to everyone. We had planned to stay open due to the sun coming later in the day, but the gridlock on the roads made it impossible for Dorset Food Links to deliver our lunches and so therefore we had to close. Unfortunately, we just didn't have enough cans of baked beans and bread for the 120 children we serve everyday. Whilst we didn't want to close, we hope you took the opportunity to enjoy some magical moments in the snow.



Despite the hiccup of the snow, the children continue to 'fly high' this week. It is always such a joy to walk through the classrooms and see the children so engaged in their learning. Year 4 showed off their musician skills by explaining what a graphic score is and demonstrating some body percussion. Year 3 showed off their World War 1 museum, where the children confidently told me what they have learnt. Year 2 have been explaining how we can save the planet in preparation for their report writing, whilst Year 1 have been explaining that we can have an = sign at the start of a number sentence. Reception have been getting very technical with their science skills whilst looking at leaves and have learnt a new word, chlorophyll!

Upon the conclusion of the consultation period all responses will be considered carefully and a report will be presented to Dorset Council's Cabinet meeting on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> February 2025.

## Free school meals

A free healthy meal is available every school day to children whose parents or carers receive qualifying benefits. Please visit the Dorset Council Free School Meals web page for more information to see if your child is eligible. This contains a quick, easy, and confidential online application form. The financial information you provide will not be seen by your child's school or teachers, and the school will only be notified if your application is approved. If your child qualifies for benefit-related free school meals, they also get access to free activities and nutritious food in the school holidays: Find out more. Even if your child is in reception, year 1 or year 2 and already gets universal infant free school meals (UIFSM), please complete a free school meals application form if you think you might be eligible. If approved, you will gain access to free holiday activities and your school will receive extra funding (called pupil premium) to support your child's education and development: Apply for free school meals - Dorset Council.
